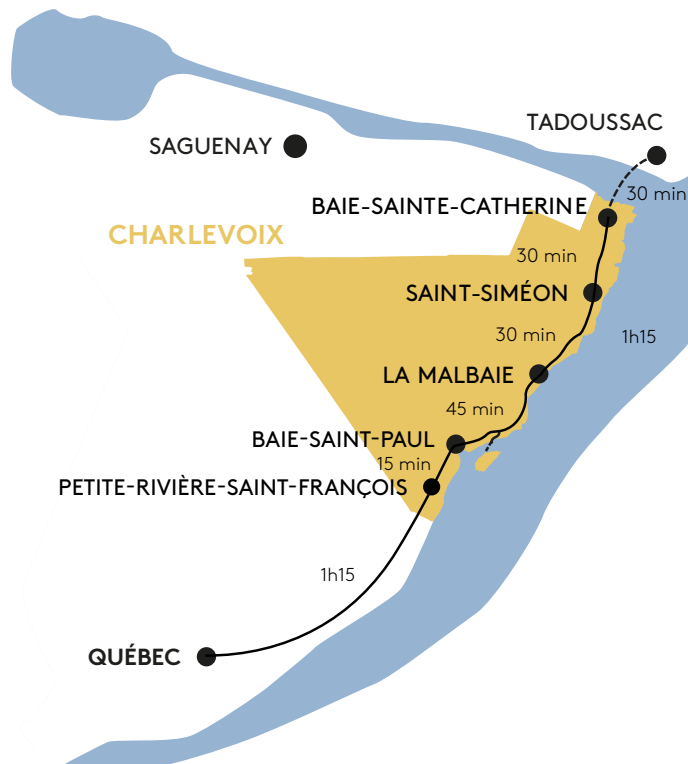


Day 1 | Fill up on energy

At the top of the Petite-Rivière-Saint-François village and overlooking the Saint-Laurent River is your very first stop, the **Massif de Charlevoix**.

A 4-season destination, this mountain offers a wide range of outdoor activities and is the perfect spot to recharge your battery... both for your body and your car. In Baie-Saint-Paul, park your car and set off to discover the many art galleries, restaurants and shops on the famous **rue Saint-Jean-Baptiste**.

The exhibitions at the **Musée d'art contemporain de Baie-Saint-Paul** amaze everyone who passes through.

Visit the **Musée maritime de Charlevoix**, **Alpagas Charlevoix**, **Domaine Forget de Charlevoix** and **Les Ateliers Charlevoix** to better understand the passion that drives the locals. End your day in La Malbaie, a town with timeless charm that has been drawing visitors in search of fresh air and serene beauty for over 200 years, and partake in a number of activities like a visit to **Musée de Charlevoix**, climbing the incredible **via ferrata** rock faces, or making a stop at the **Casino de Charlevoix**.

Day 3 | In the heart of the mountains

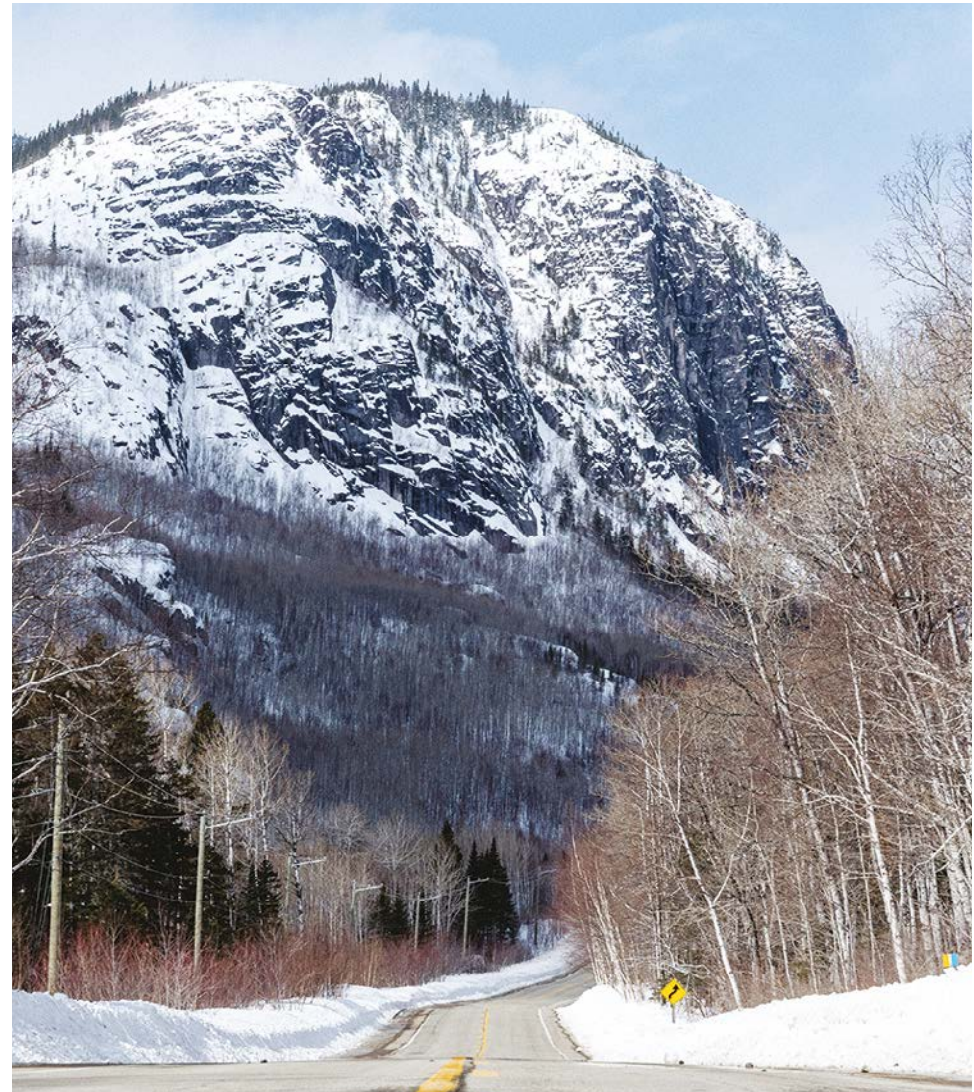
A trip to Charlevoix isn't complete without experiencing its impressive peaks. The 35km passage on **Mountain Road** is a feast for the eyes sure to move any passenger. From Saint-Aimé-des-Lacs to Saint-Urbain via Notre-Dame-des-Monts, the most beautiful mountains reveal their individual uniqueness in spectacular fashion. Before leaving the region, make sure to make a few quick stops to stock up on local products. Don't miss the foie gras, the star of the show at the **Ferme Basque de Charlevoix**, or the beauty products and emu meat at the **Centre de l'Émeu de Charlevoix**. On your way back to Baie-Saint-Paul, on route 138, the **Laiterie Charlevoix** is the go-to place to sample local delicacies.
