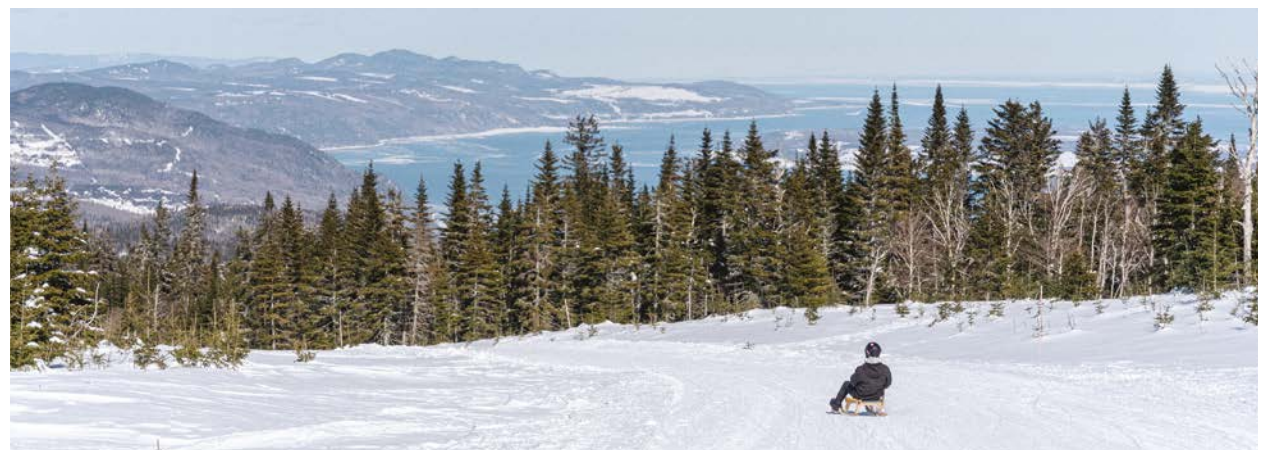
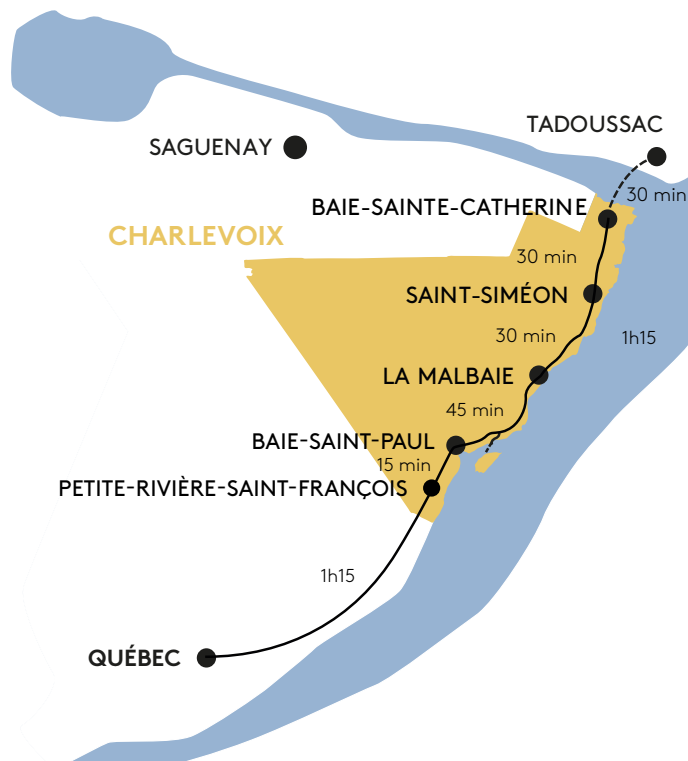
## Day 1 | Petite-Rivière-Saint-François
