A taste of Charlevoix

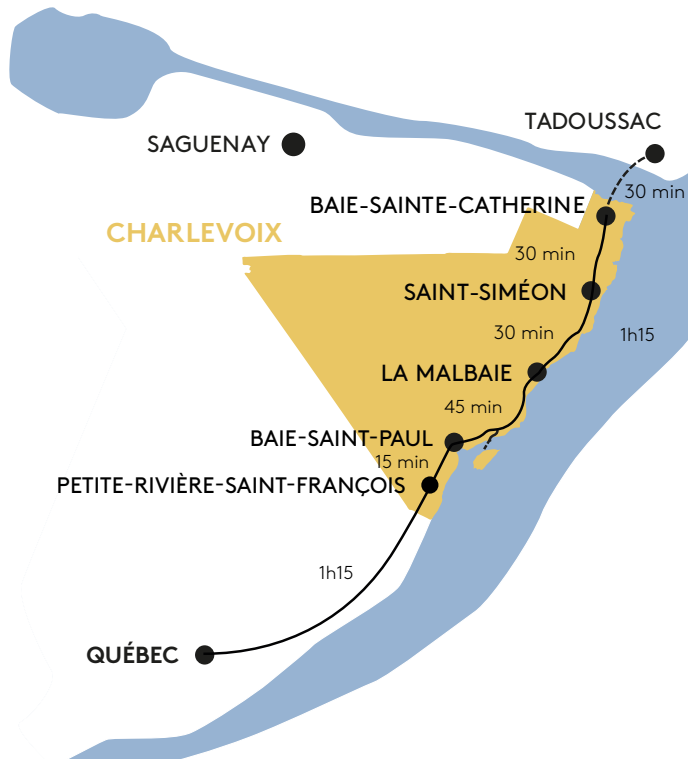

Day 1 | Feed your curiosity

Take the road from Québec over to Baie-Saint-Paul and get ready for a whole new world of tastes. Take a guided tour of **Domaine de la Vallée du Bras** and taste Omerto, the first tomato wine in the world. Visit **Azulée**, a farm known for its lavender culinary products. These sweet aromas are sure to get your appetite going, so head over to **Le Saint-Pub** to satisfy your hunger while you sample craft beers at one of the oldest microbreweries in Québec. Filled with art galleries, shops and local vendors, **Saint-Jean-Baptiste Street** is the perfect place to keep on discovering. End the day with an authentic culinary experience at **Le Diapason** restaurant.

Day 2 | Local provisions

To stock up on local products and cheese, you first have to stop at **Laiterie Charlevoix** and then head to **Famille Migneron de Charlevoix** who makes fine artisanal cheeses, liquors and organic wines. These two shops are the perfect places to pick up picnic provisions and enjoy the rest of the day. At night, you have two standout options: **Faux Bergers** located in the middle of an agricultural estate and **Mouton Noir** with its terrace overlooking the beautiful Du Gouffre River.

Day 3 | Gourmet stops

The **St. Lawrence Route** is one of the most beautiful panoramic routes in North America. Take it to meet up with unique and welcoming producers like Jardin des Chefs, Chocolaterie du Village, Miellerie du cratère de Charlevoix, Ferme Éboulmontaise, Alpagas Charlevoix and more. This flavourful day is not complete without a delicious dinner at **Chez Truchon**. And if you still have the energy, end the night at the **Casino de Charlevoix**.

Day 4 | A ton of possibilities

Choose between these three options: take a guided tour with **Agrotours Charlevoix** or **Zofa Excursions**. You will be in good hands either way. You can also return to Québec via the **Mountain Road** which runs through the national parks. For hikers, these paths lead to paradise. It is also a route filled with exceptional producers like Safran Nordique, Ferme Basque de Charlevoix, Centre de l'Émeu de Charlevoix, Viandes bio de Charlevoix and Charcuterie Charlevoisienne. Finally, you can head towards Baie-Sainte-Catherine to observe magnificent marine life onboard **Croisières AML**. You will pass by Cidrerie Port-au-Persil and Fromagerie St-Fidèle to sample real Québec cheese and tasty ice cream.



5 original activities to do along the way

- Board the **Train de Charlevoix** for amazing river views
- Walk through the forest with **Forêt Gourmande** to discover the woody spices of Massif de Charlevoix
- Wander in **Hautes-Gorges-de-la-Rivière-Malbaie National Park** to marvel at the landscape
- Discover the authentic side of **Isle-aux-Coudres**
- Visit **Domaine Forget de Charlevoix** to quench your thirst for culture
